Thank you for all you are continuing to do to support your children during this time. Please find below some reminders about where to access materials and what to do if you need support.

Remote Learning

It has been wonderful to see the engagement through Purple Mash from children who are working from home. Thank you for your feedback about the new planning format and support resources issued this week. We are pleased that they were helpful and have listened to feedback regarding some access issues with certain devices. This week there will be links available to access the embedded documents on the planning and teachers will also email the class the PowerPoints and PDFs, so that the children can access directly from the Purple Mash Platform if home devices do not allow access from the main planning document. We are again continuing to post the learning via the class pages on the school website.

The printed packs are still available for collection, for those who have requested one. Please ensure these are collected this week (Monday 22nd - Wednesday 24th). We will be offering this again later in the term so please look out for further information to be sent via ParentMail.


