



Keeping in Touch Letter

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have attached a letter from Jeremy Piper, our CEO, regarding the preparations for the end of this term and academic year. Although the letter refers to a reduction in current pupil numbers from the 10th July for some schools, this does not apply to us. We will continue to be open to the first priority group during the week beginning 13th July - vulnerable children, children with EHCPs, children of key workers and EYFS - but as stated in the letter, term will end on Friday 17th July for all pupils.

We feel it is important to enable all pupils to return in the safest way possible, to spend time with their current class teacher and provide some closure. We will therefore be inviting all year groups into school in bubbles of no more than 15, for a 1 hour timetabled session with their current class adults. We will need to ensure that classes are timetabled in groups of no more than 15, so that social distancing can be adhered to. There will also be an opportunity, during this time, for the children to say hello to their new teacher for the next academic year. Further details will follow on Friday 26th June and we will share our full transition plans with you at that time.

As much as we want to see every single one of our children back in our classrooms, the safety of your children and our staff has to come above everything else. Thank you for your continued patience and support.
