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Rewards and Consequences

- Rewards come in the form of moving up the ladder. We also have verbal and non-verbal rewards, gem points and Merit Owls.
- Consequences come from following the consequence chart and may include reminders, writing a letter of apology, or staying in from break for five or ten minutes.



PE

- Trainers are needed daily for the Golden Mile.
- PE sessions will usually be on Tuesday or Thursday.
- In terms 1, 3 and 5, we will have Superstars provision on Wednesday afternoons.
- PE kit will be sent home at the end of each half term.



Home Learning

- Spellings are handed out on a Monday and tested on a Friday.
- Pick and Mix Home Learning will be sent out at the beginning of term and should be brought in on Fridays.

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Assessment

- Assessment is carried out regularly in lessons, guiding where we go next with the learning journey.
- We will have assessments at the end of Maths units and overall terms.
- As we head through the year and get closer to SATs, we will be making sure to have more practice papers so that the children are prepared.
- SATs week begins Monday 11th May 2020.
