Inside, there are delicious-looking fruits, including a lot of blueberries! There is a bottle labelled Banana Berry Burst and hanging on the back of a chair is a blue jumper. There is also a blue coat hanging on a peg. I wonder who the new owner of the inn is?

Make some Banana Berry Burst at home with your child (bananas, berries, fruit juice to loosen and some ice whizzed into a blender). You could add a drizzle of honey to sweeten. You could pretend to fill some bottles with Banana Berry Burst to put into 'The Pop Inn.' Don't forget to ask your child to add a label to the bottles.




Maths


Collect a set of objects and count how many you have altogether.
Give a friend some of the objects and hide the rest in a bucket or box.
Can your friend work out how many objects you have hidden?



Change the number of objects and the number hidden each time.
Then take it in turns to work out how many are hidden.



This is the end of our learning focusing on the numbers 0 - 5. Ask your child to practise reading and writing them as often as they need to, in order to feel confident with these numbers.


	<p>Funky fingers</p>	 <p>Repeatedly squeezing a clothes peg open is very good for developing the muscles in children's fingers, which are essential for writing. Set up two containers with cotton wool balls in one (or similar) and challenge your child to move them from one container to the other using a clothes peg.</p>

The Pop Inn

Imagine if The Pop Inn sold all of your favourite drinks. Which drinks would be sold? Ask your child to draw a picture of their favourite drink. They could then add a label, phrase or sentence to go with it. It would be helpful if you could draw a line for your child to write on and then support them in hearing and recording sounds in words. I wouldn't expect all sounds to be heard and the children won't have correct spelling for many/all of the words. Below is an example.

'I like apple juice' might look like 'I lik apl js.'

Tricky word music

Set up your own band of musical instruments (use anything you have around the house - kitchen utensils are particularly good for this). Stick tricky words onto the 'instruments' and sing/say the words as you play. You might want to start off making a simple pattern, switching between two or three words before using all words in a piece of music, when feeling confident. I would love to see the music made so please do upload your videos to the ILD. Use your Tricky words sheets to choose words currently being learned (or use the tricky words we are learning in our phonics lessons).



What do you notice when you use a tall, thin cup or a short, wide cup?




Topic




