	Phonics	<b>Watch the pre-recorded phonics video - Monday phonics video (wb 25.01.21).</b> You will find this in The Learning Zone of the ILD.
	English	<u>Little Blue</u> Little Blue is the new owner of The Pop Inn. Oh no, something has happened! <b>Watch the English video for Monday (wb 25.01.21) to see what it is.</b>  The Pop Inn has been ransacked! Look at the paw prints that have been left. All of the Banana Berry Burst has been taken, as well as Little Blue's coat! Oh no, where is Little Blue?  Who do you think the paw prints belong to? It must be an animal that likes berries and honey. Have a look on the internet, with an adult, to see if you can find out which animal they belong to. Top tip - count the number of toes.

	<p>Ask your child to draw a picture of the animal they think ransacked The Pop Inn. They can then either label the animal or write a sentence explaining which animal it was. <b>Please remember that we wouldn't expect your child to be able to hear every sound in the words and they should just write down the sounds they can hear. If they can hear a phase 3 digraph/trigraph we haven't yet learned, e.g. the igh in might, then please do show them the sound from the phase 3 soundmat for them to copy. If their sentence was, I think it might have been a bear, they might write, I think it might have been a ber (and this would be a fantastic effort).</b></p>


# 30 Day LEGO Challenge



<b>English</b>	<p>We have found out that it was a bear who broke into The Pop Inn and took all of the Banana Berry Burst. Did you work this out too?</p> <p>There is a bear on the loose and Little Bue and his grandma could be in trouble. We need your help! Download the talking tree warning leaf from The Learning Zone of the ILD (or make your own) and ask your child if they could make a warning notice to warn others that there is a bear on the loose. Below are a couple of examples of things they could write.</p> <p>Warning! There is a bear on the loose.          Be careful of the bear.          Bear in the woods.</p>




Once they have written their warning, start to think about how Little Blue could help. (Top tip - use ideas from the story of Little Red to help your child to come up with ideas.)





Have you found all the possible ways?





White Rose Maths

Ask your child to practise writing the number 8. A good tip is to start like the letter s (without the whoosh in) and then cross over back to the start.

	<p><b>English</b></p>	<p>Think about the character of Little Blue. We know that he likes all things blue. Ask your child to create a character description of Little Blue. They will need to draw a picture of Little Blue and some of the things he likes (all blue). They then need to either label their character and their things, eg. Little Blue, a blue duck, a blue ball, a blue balloon etc. or write a sentence to describe Little Blue. For example. Little Blue has a blue coat and a blue ball. Please add to the ILD.</p>



Phonics
