Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly, thank you for the tremendous support and understanding that you have continued to show. The team is working incredibly hard to respond to the lockdown announcement and we know that the information from us arrived very late last night due to all schools who use ParentMail doing the same thing!

Please find some details below about the remote learning for this week.

Remote Learning

Remote learning will be set at the beginning of each week and can be found on your child's class page on the school website. The remote learning for this week has already been set.

The remote learning document should have links to everything your child will need for their lesson. When your child has finished their learning, they will need to upload what they have done to Purple Mash (by going to the Work tab and clicking 'upload'). This could be a clear picture of the learning or a document.

Parents of EYFS should upload their learning to the ILD, instead of Purple Mash.

Your child will receive feedback from their teacher for set learning they complete and this will be given via Purple Mash (or the ILD for EYFS). Your child should have their Purple Mash login at home and EYFS parents/carers should have their ILD logins. If you need another copy, or cannot access Purple Mash or the ILD, it is important that you get in touch with the school office as quickly as possible, as this will be a key part of your child's learning.

An activity pack has been assembled for each class, with a range of paper copies of English and Maths activities - this is completely optional and in response to previous remote learning feedback where some parents found this to be helpful. These will be available for collection from tomorrow morning, at the front of the school between 9.30 and 2pm for one person to collect for a family, following social distancing, the one-way system and wearing a face mask/covering please.

Each class will be having a daily Zoom session during the period of remote learning. This will be used to support and direct the children's learning, rather than an opportunity to catch up or socialise. The current timings for Class Zooms for the remainder of this week will be sent out via ParentMail. EYFS and KS1 daily Zooms will be half an hour long. KS2 daily Zooms will be 40 minutes. The times and links may be different in the weeks to follow and we will let you know the plans for next week on Friday. Please read the Zoom information attached to this email.
