Dear Parents/Carers,

This is a letter regarding all the information for our Sports Day this academic year. As you will see from this letter, our Sports Day is going to look very different this year. This is due to current Covid restrictions and the guidance we have in place to follow our current risk assessment. We know that this is going to be different from our usual years but we hope you understand that this is to keep our children safe.

Sports Day will take place over 3 days. All the children will take part in track and field events. The field events will take place on **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June** and the track events will take place on **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June and Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July**. Sadly, for the reasons mentioned above, no parents will be allowed on the school site to watch our sporting events.

For our Sports Days, all classes will be given a time to go outside and compete for their House Teams. These are **Snowy**, **Barn**, **Tawny** and **Eagle**. The field events will consist of throwing, standing long jump, bunny hop, a bean bag throw for EYFS/KS1 and a shot putt throw for KS2. The track events will consist of a fun runs, skills races, relays and sprinting. Children can earn Sportsmanship Points for cheering and taking part to add to their grand total.

We do understand that parents would like to be able to see these special moments and so photographs will be taken during the races and afterwards at the photo booth area too. These will be uploaded to the school website, where parental permission has been given, so that all can enjoy.

Children will need to be prepared for their sporting days. This means they need to make sure they have the correct PE kit in school, including trainers. Normal PE kit is acceptable for all events but if possible, a coloured t-shirt matching your child's house team can be worn. Children must have a water bottle and sun hat/cream if there is warmer weather.
