

## English

Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations. Represent own ideas, thoughts & feelings through roleplay & stories.

Say, read and begin to write the phonemes / graphemes, e.g. /s/.

Begin to segment and blend.

Practice blending and reading high frequency words.

*Home learning idea: Video your child talking about the story 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers.*

## PSED

Understand how it feels to belong and that we are similar and different.

Start to recognise and manage their feelings.

Enjoy working with others to make school a good place to be.

Understand why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands.

Starting to understand children's rights and this means we should all be allowed to learn and play.

Learning what being responsible means.

*Home learning idea: Write a 'Wow' moment for your child and send it to school.*

## Topic

Learn about the Christian Creation story.

Practise and perform rhymes and songs linked to creation.

Contribute to whole class artwork focused on creation.

Talk about similarities and differences between animals and share favourite animals.

*Home learning idea: Ask your child to talk about a place that is special to them in our world.*

## Physical Development
